Adoption of meeting's Agenda

Perimeter Land Management – Chair Sean Espinosa

- a. Dog poop in bags has been found in the perimeter. Options:
 - i. Not do anything
 - ii. Get some 'pick up poop' signs and place them near the houses that have complained.

Perimeter Landscape Committee - Chair Linda Slechta

- a. There are a number of dead plants in the perimeter landscape that will need to be addressed sometime. These should be removed by Cascadian and we can then determine if they need to be replaced or not.
